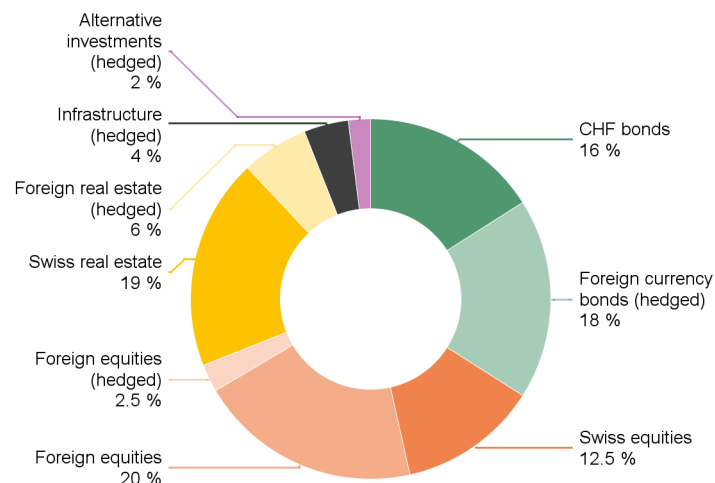


Strategy description

The strategy, inceptioned by FCT, invests in bonds, equities, real estate, infrastructure and alternative investments with a focus on diversification. The investment funds making up the strategy are managed by various best-in-class managers. The investment funds are managed passively or actively, depending on asset class. The strategic equity allocation is 35%.
